John Walker currently serves as the Treasurer for the Minnesota Disabled American Veterans, as well as Legislative Chairman for the St. Paul Chapter 2.

In these volunteer positions, he ensures that the assets of the Minnesota DAV are appropriately invested and monitored, and that the financial records of the Foundation are properly maintained and preserved. He also is responsible for reporting the finances of the Foundation to the Board, reviewing chapter annual financial reports, and other services necessary to fulfill the purposes of the Foundation.



Walker joined the Minnesota DAV St. Paul Chapter in September 2009. He served as Chapter Commander from 2016-2017 but decided to not seek another term. The reason behind this decision was so others could have a chance to lead the chapter. He continued to help train others who were interested in being commander or other leadership roles.

While serving as Commander of the St. Paul Chapter, Walker was asked if he would accept the appointment of Treasurer for the Minnesota DAV Foundation and the Chair of the Finance Committee, where he is currently serving.

Walker is originally from Port Gibson, Miss. He served for six years in the Mississippi National Guard 155th Infantry Division, and his unit was attached to the First Calvary.
