

**DAV of Minnesota Foundation (“Foundation”)
PRIVACY POLICY**

The Foundation recognizes that in the course of its operation, it comes into possession of the personal information of donors and other persons having an interest in our programs. For these purposes, “Personal Information” means any information about a person, however acquired. It includes, **without limitation**, a person’s name, physical address, telephone number(s), email addresses, and credit card/bank account information.

The Foundation acquires Personal Information in a variety of ways, including, **without limitation**, through the recognition and preservation of data about website visitors and through the voluntary submission of data to the Foundation by individuals. The privacy rules articulated herein apply to all Personal Information in possession of the Foundation, regardless of how acquired.

The Foundation takes the issue of privacy very seriously and has thus adopted the following policies regarding the treatment of Personal Information.

PERSONAL INFORMATION ABOUT DONORS

- The Foundation will not trade, sell or share any donor’s Personal Information with anyone outside of DAV.
- The Foundation will not send to its donors any mailings, including fundraising mailings, on behalf of any other organization.
- All credit card and banking information of donors is handled in accordance with best industry practices. Credit card and banking information is not stored by the Foundation.
- Personal Information of donors will be used by the Foundation only for the following purposes:
 - To encourage financial and other support of programs for disabled veterans;
 - To process donations (including provision of receipts);
 - To respond to inquiries and other requests for information; and
 - To provide timely and important information concerning issues related to the mission of the organization.
